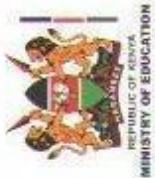

- vii. Take up such other activities as both the organizations mutually decide.


#### Funding




