'Association for Learning Performing Arts and Normative Action (A.L.P.A.N.A.)' a registered voluntary organization in New Delhi, hereinafter be referred to as 'A.L.P.A.N.A.'

and

'The Salvation Army Likoni School for The Blind' an organization working for the cause of humanity based at P.O. Box 96089-80100, Likoni, Mombasa, Kenya, hereinafter be referred to as 'LSTB'

Purpose & Scope

This MoU is intended to build inutual cooperation between 'A.L.P.A.N.A.' and 'LSTB' so as to learn and assimilate the experience gained through the activities conducted by both the organizations. While the special emphasis is for ensuring the empowerment of the physically and mentally challenged / disabled persons and creating avenues for wider exposure, both organizations will jointly work towards promotion of halistic development of their respective countries.

Background

'A.L.P.A.N.A.' and 'LSTB' have worked on the promotion of inclusive arts through an international event titled, SAMBHAV held at New Delhi and mutually benefitted. Both the organizations aim at furthering their intention to work together through this MoU.

Responsibilities under this MoU

Both the organizations 'A.L.P.A.N.A.' and 'LSTB' have mutually agreed to

- i. Exchange their wide experience and ideas in their respective areas of activities and specially with reference to their endeavour in the respective countries of origin.
- ii. Encourage joint performances of each other in their respective countries and explore the opportunities for providing suitable platforms for conducting their activities.

- iii. Make efforts to sponsor or invite each other for participation in national and international level events with which they are associated in future.
- iv. Make efforts to organise special events or avail opportunities in events organized at the national / international level where the other party can participate. A special effort will be made to ensure such participation at least once in a calendar year in their respective countries of origin.
- v. Promote the cause of inclusive arts and inclusive growth.
- vi. Undertake joint projects for promotion of art and culture.
- vii. Take up such other activities as both the organizations mutually decide.

Funding

While expanding the areas of cooperation and helping each other to expand their areas of activities, both the organizations will strive to bring more and more opportunities for achieving objectives in their respective countries and abroad. While inviting each other for fulfilling the objectives of this MoU, the host organization will bear the expenditure towards the travel and local hospitality for other organization so invited. There will be reciprocity in such arrangements.

Effective date of Signing

This non-legally binding MoU shall come into effect, upon the signatures, at New Delhi, of authorized officials of 'A.I., P.A.N.A.' and 'LSTB' and shall remain in force for a period of three years, and, get extended, automatically, for further periods of three years, unless terminated by either party with a notice in writing at least three (3) months prior to termination.
